Proposed 2012 Budget

New Church Child Protection Policy Approved

A new church child protection policy has been developed. We believe that the security and safety of our children is essential. This policy was included in the church organizational manual which was approved in the November church conference.

The policy states that any adult (church staff, church member, or non-church member) involved in the ministry of HBC who works with minor children in any capacity will be required to complete a consent form for the purpose of conducting a criminal background check. The Jones County Sheriff's Department will perform the criminal background check to determine whether any prospective worker has been convicted of any crimes against a minor. Persons whose background check reveals a conviction of any crime(s) against a minor will be considered ineligible to serve in any capacity with minor children at our church. The consent forms are available in the church foyer. We request that anyone wishing to serve with children in our church, please complete this form as soon as possible. Please return the completed form to the pastor or the church office. We encourage all current workers, church leaders, and parents to participate. If you have any questions, please speak with a deacon or the church staff. Thank you helping to ensure the safety of our children.
