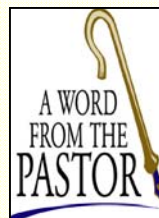

Testimonies and Special Music



As Baptists we proclaim to be people of the Book. We profess our love for and devotion to the Holy Scriptures and yet some contemporary statistics are alarming. Fewer than half of American adults can name the four Gospels. About half of people surveyed indicate the "lack of time" as the reason for not reading the Bible. For 40 days, I wish to challenge us to do something that 65% of adult Christians say they have never done- read and listen to the New Testament.

You've Got the Time will begin on Ash Wednesday, February 17. By listening to the New Testament for 28 minutes per day- you will complete listening to the entire New Testament by Palm Sunday. We will partner with the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship and Faith Comes by Hearing to make this project become a reality. They will provide free MP3 discs for every youth and adult and a free audio Kidz Bible for all children. If you prefer, cassettes or CD's may be purchased by February 3. See the Sunday church bulletin for details. We will collect an offering that will be used exclusively for the purchasing of audio Bibles in other languages to aid the work of missionaries around the globe.

This 40-day plan will help us as a church- from senior adults to preschoolers to be involved in the same goal- listening to and allowing God's Word to shape our lives together. It also provides an opportunity to help people who have never heard the Gospel to hear it in audio format. Allow the power of God's Word to speak to your heart "***Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.***" Romans 10:17.

Summer 2010 Preview for Kids Grades K-5

Summer will be here before you know it! Make a special note of these dates and the various costs for camps, along with DEPOSIT DUE dates. "Saddle Ridge Ranch" is the theme for this year's VBS, set for June 13-17. Get your cowboy and western gear ready! This year's Day Camp for kids grades (completed K) thru 3rd grade is "Camp Healthy." We will learn about keeping our bodies – God's temple, healthy! We will also learn disability awareness. Space is limited to 60 children and the cost is \$70 per child. Parents who work with us all week pay no fees for their children who attend. Camp fees are DUE in church office by May 2. RA and GA camp at Kaleo is July 12–16 and is for boys and girls grades 4–up. 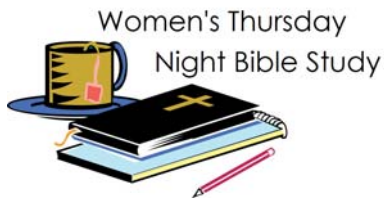
