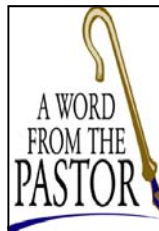

As we enter the final quarter of this calendar year- let me address you directly and frankly about a need our church faces. We are approximately \$40,000 under budget for 2017. Moreover, our actual budget expenses exceed our actual budget receipts by approximately \$20,000.

Despite our best efforts to be frugal and careful, we find ourselves in this dilemma. We cannot nor should not think this issue will simply be magically resolved by someone else. You will shortly receive correspondence from our church regarding this need. This letter will offer one way in which every person can help us meet this challenge and help resolve this concern. I urge you to pray about your level of giving and give generously to support the current and future ministry of Haddock Baptist Church.

All of us have financial obligations each month: mortgage, childcare, car payments, groceries, cable tv, cell phone, credit card bills, tithes and offerings, etc... For many giving to the church does not make it very high on the list of priorities. And in reality, some families send their tithes to Visa, MasterCard, or American Express each month. Few people are motivated to give out of guilt and the purpose of this article is not to increase anyone's sense of guilt. Rather it is my goal to encourage each of us to make a list of our priorities and to give accordingly. I believe the Church of Jesus Christ is worthy of my family and me giving to its ministries our tithes and offerings! I do not want to be accused as some Old Testament believers were accused by the prophet Malachi of robbing from God what was rightfully only God's.

An old preacher once said: the Church has the financial resources to cover its expenses and ministries- the problem is, he explained, it often remains in our hands rather than God's hands.

At the age of 23, George Beverly Shea had a hard decision to make. He could accept a job offer in a secular singing position in New York City with a great salary and wide respect, or he could continue singing in churches and for Christian radio programs. While sitting at the family piano, he started to prepare a special hymn for the Sunday service.

On the piano he found a poem by Mr. Rhea F. Miller. He immediately began to compose the music for the poem and used the song that same morning in his father's church service.
