Our calendars help set the rhythms of our life. We mark important dates to remember like birthdays, anniversaries, and such. We also record appointments, reminders, and responsibilities on our calendar to help us use our time wisely.

Early in history the Church recognized the value of the calendar in keeping with the biblical admonition found in Psalm 90:12, *Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.* In one sense, we live with two calendars measuring our time and our use of it. We have the secular calendar marking important historical dates, etc. and the sacred calendar marking holy days to commemorate. We might consider which gets most of our attention?

Our *Celebrating Grace Hymnal* tells us: "it might surprise us to discover that the most radical event placed on the calendar for Christians is often taken for granted: the observation of Sunday as the day of weekly worship. Early Christians celebrated the resurrection of our Lord every Sunday – this shift of worship from the Sabbath to the first day was one of the Church's earliest uses of using the calendar to help proclaim its faith."

Of course, on the Church calendar the two most recognizable dates are Easter and Christmas. To accentuate the importance of Easter- the Church came up with a season of preparation called Lent- which begins on Ash Wednesday, and continues for 40 days (excluding Sundays). Lent (an Old English word for spring) is often seen as a time of renewal for believers. This year interestingly the secular calendars and the sacred calendars overlap as Ash Wednesday falls on February 14, Valentine's Day and Easter falls on April 1, April Fools' Day.

This year may we give serious thought to how we will prepare our hearts for the Easter season and consider what disciplines we might choose to practice to help bring about a renewal of our own faith and commitment to God and the Church.

Dear church family,

Abide with Me is one of the best-loved English hymns of the past 150 years. We see this both in its enduring usage in churches today and in its ongoing appearances in modern culture (for example, in the opening ceremony of the 2012 Summer Olympics).

The author of the hymn, Henry Francis Lyte, was an Anglican priest of All Saints Church in Brixham, England. He was also a published poet and accomplished hymn writer who also penned *Jesus, I My Cross Have Taken* and *Praise, My Soul, the King of Heaven*. For most of his life, Lyte suffered from poor health, and would regularly travel abroad for relief. Lyte wrote the poem in 1847 and set it to music while he lay dying from tuberculosis. He died three weeks after its completion.

Each verse ends in the plea “abide with me,” making the hymn a sustained call for God’s personal presence in every stage and condition of life. The hymn resonates deeply with the hearts of those who feel their need of God. The hymn is popular across many Christian denominations and was a favorite of King George V and Mahatma Gandhi.
