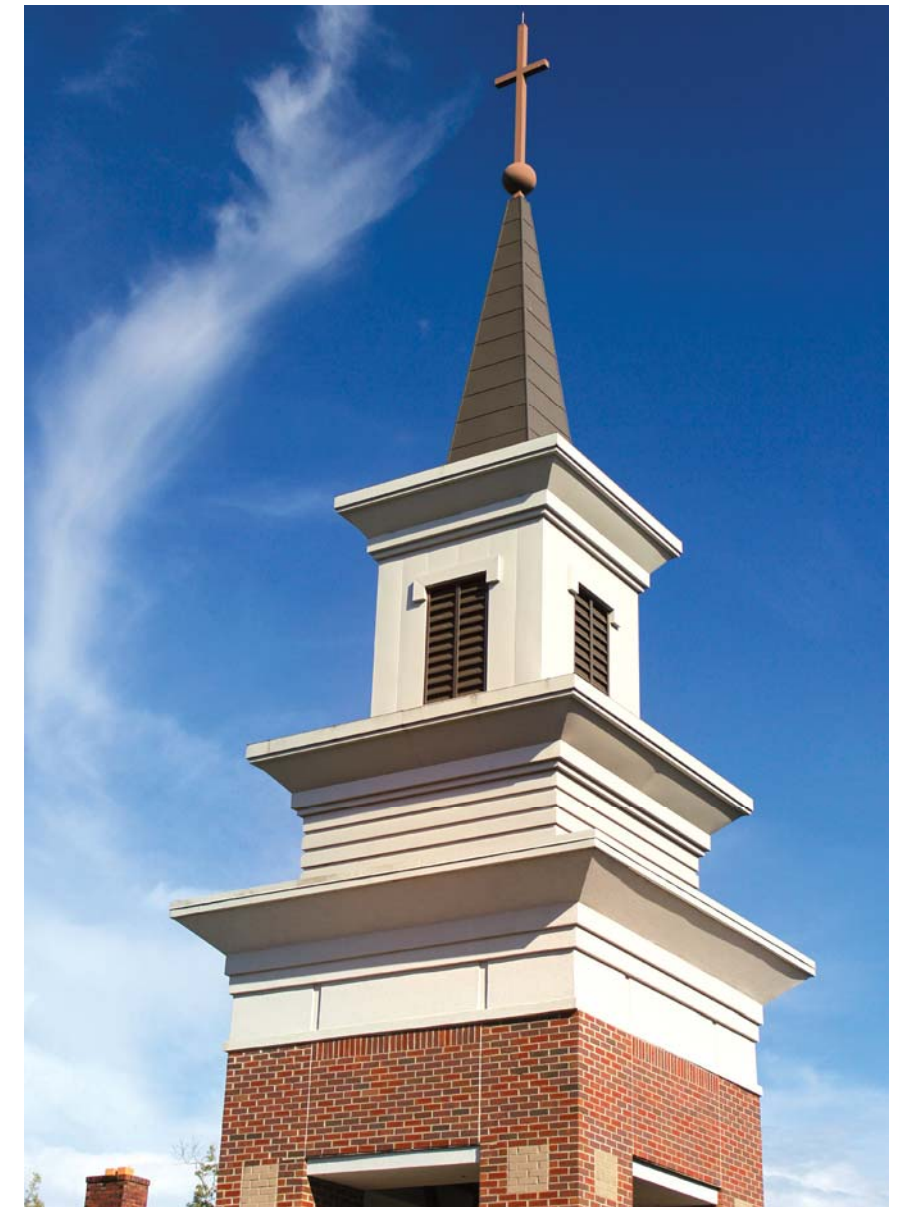

Those wishing to become members are invited to come forward during the hymn of commitment to share their decision with the pastor or schedule an appointment to discuss your decision.
