- Team** to work on lights in the fellowship hall.

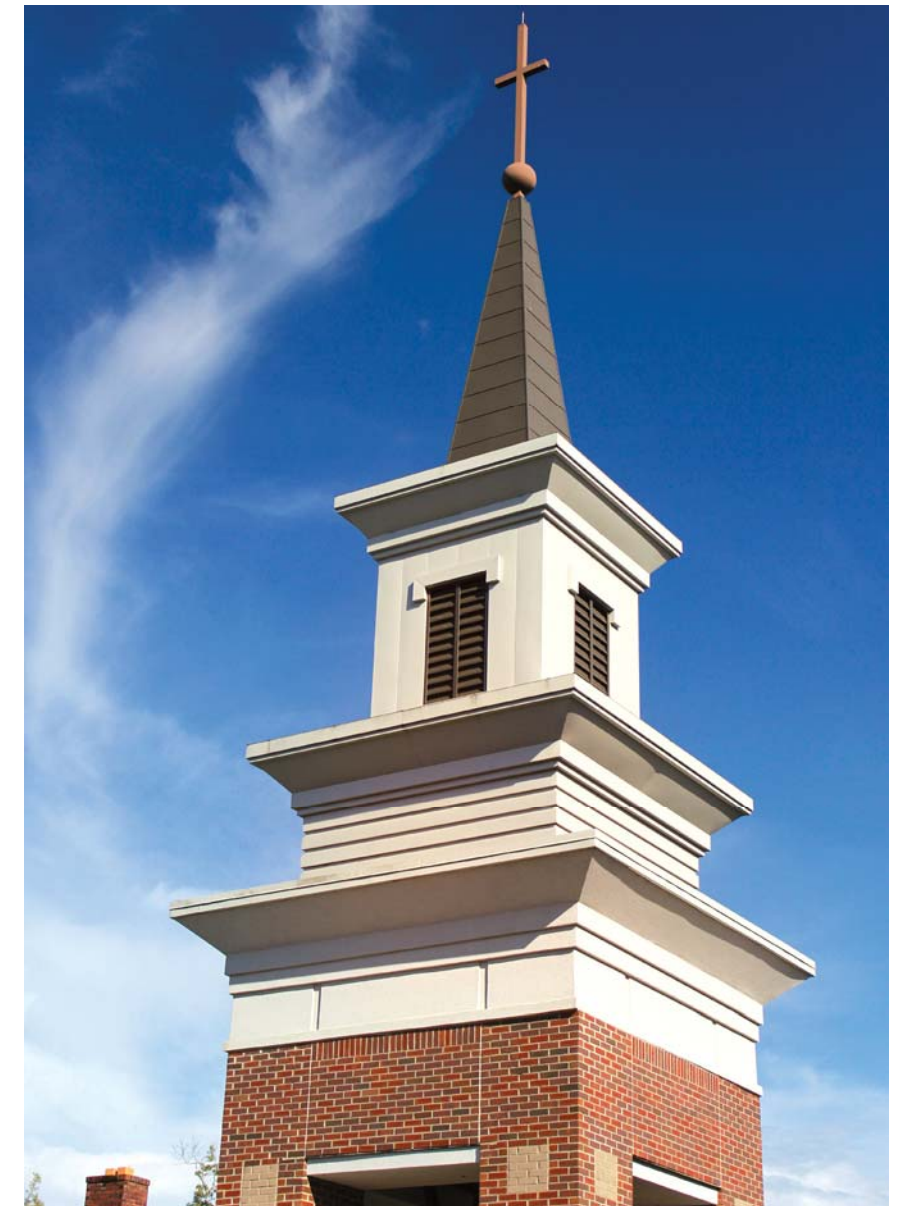
