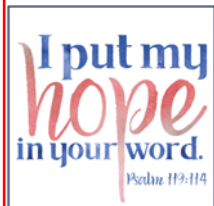
Please RSVP to Lisa Lee. We will enjoy pizza and fellowship as we get ready to go back to school!
